#### **VOLUNTEER AREAS:**

Each year for our anniversary celebration, Jack captures the beautiful moments we share as a community. He has photographed events for the Center like the anniversary galas. #### WHY DID YOU WANT TO VOLUNTEER AT THE CENTER?
