The workers will be officially certified by the American Green Zone Alliance to operate this ecofriendly equipment. The technology program is in full swing, with day workers engaging in in-person classes to acquire valuable computer skills. Additionally, we are forming partnerships with other organizations to launch our Sustainable Gardening Program and Bike Maintenance Repair program, with the goal of providing workers with a range of skills for increased job opportunities and better serve YOU.

So far, during 2023, in the field of workforce development, we have connected nearly 300 workers with over 1,000 employers for a total of 7,788 job placements.
